## NOTICE TO PERSON(S)

- The statement of withdrawal from Partnership Operating under Fictitious Business Name must be published in a newspaper once a week for four successive weeks and an affidavit of publication filed with the county clerk within 30 days after publication has been accomplished. The statement should be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the county where the principal place of business is located. The statement should be published in such county in a newspaper that circulates in the area where the e (Business & business is conducted. Professions Code Section 17917)
- 2. Any person who executes, files or publishes any fictitious business name statement, knowing that such statement is false, in whole or in part, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00). (Business & Professions Code Section 17930)
